QCM/RM PT Rounds

There are times where offering certain types of samples in a Proficiency Testing Programme are met with challenges (safety considerations, efficiency and economy of scale, etc.) These challenges are better addressed by sourcing material from other suppliers, which may include other PT providers or manufacturers of Reference or QC Materials. In addition, there are advantages in using these materials to benchmark laboratory performance against a KNOWN value (and its uncertainty), either using certified, or uncertified materials. Upcoming PT rounds which are planning to use such materials include:

- WaterChek Disinfection byproducts
 - Trihalomethanes ٠
 - Haloacetic Acids
- BeverageChek Micro (under development)
 - Lactic Acid Bacteria ٠
 - Alicyclobacillus
 - Brettanomyces sp.
 - Pediococcus sp.

Raw Data Summary Report

Another report which is not part of our standard ILCP service is the **Raw Data Summary.**

Laboratories have requested this report for various reasons, including to manually calculate statistics not routinely provided on reports. Previously, this was predominantly used to calculate Z-scores for programmes which provided a normalised assessment (Normalised Difference), however Z-score reports are now available for these programmes as an alternative or additional offering.

The Raw Data Summary provides the following information:

- Round
- Test Reported Name
- Sample ID
- Laboratory (all others will have an alias)
- Report Number
- Method
- Result

The summary is generated based on selected rounds and categories. The excel format allows for further filtering, easy analysis and calculations.

It is available for an additional cost, as a one-off or on-going report but only for rounds in which a laboratory participates.
